

#### - COMPLICATED - PRESUMED




# CAPACITY

#### **COMPLICATED:**

In California, capacity is based on a spectrum much like Autism

 An individual may have the capacity to do one thing but lack capacity to do another



Autistic Spectrum Conditions



# CAPACITY

#### Purpose:

Ensuring the protection of an individual's autonomy right to self determination

Vulnerability:

Because capacity is **PRESUMED** until a court of law says otherwise, an individual can make decisions that are:

- Not in their best interest
- Not sensible
- Actually harmful
