

#### DESCRIPTION

Perhaps the single most important introduction to "landscaping with succulents" in this decade! With red orange fowers like a compact Knipho a, and beautiful, low growing, lush green triangular leaves, it thrives in full sun, or complete north exposure shade. It tolerates water conditions from substantial regular garden watering to very dry conditions. Unlike most Aloe species that just bloom for a very short time, usually between late winter and early spring, 'Little Gem' blooms ALL YEAR ROUND on the California coastal plain. Arizona and low desert locations will see this species stop blooming during the hottest summer months.

#### DESCRIPTION

Luxurious, low growing succulent, with deep green, fat, round leaves making the perfect forest foor looking groundcover. Full sun coastal, but most importantly, one of the few efective plants for growing in troublesome dry shade, under oak trees, pines, and even eucalyptus. Likes regular garden watering, but can tolerate long periods of complete dryness. A ne mist of "baby's breath" pink fowers appears suspended above the foliage in winter and early spring. Frost tender.

### Crassula Ripple Jade | Ripple Jade





#### **DESCRIPTION\***

Of course, one of the predominant landscape plant needs is a domesticated, just-the-right-size, medium to low shrub. In the past, Pittosporum, (especially Wheeler's Dwarf) and Raphiolepsis filled this need, but they are not sufficiently drought tolerant. As they age, they get woody. In fact, rats love to gnaw on the stems and branches of some of these! Probably one of the number one, new generation shrubs for our thirsty gardens, will be 'Ripple Jade!'<sup>M</sup> It is very drought tolerant when established, the perfect size (2'-3' round), takes sun or part shade, develops no woody stems, is easily pruned and shaped, and rats and rabbits don't like them. It is cold hardy down to the low 20's, and the leaves are all twisty and cool! You just want to reach in and scruff them like on a kid's head. 



Tiny white flowers with yellow centers appear in spring through early fall, followed by edible red fruit. This perennial can be used as a lawn replacement, in coastal areas as it tolerates sand and hot inland areas as long as it has afternoon shade. It needs regular watering. Birds love this plant.



#### DESCRIPTION

Gazania krebsiana is an extremely showy plant when in fower, largely due to its warm and bright fower colour, its fower size, and its extended fowering period. The plants are semi-decumbent (prostrate to ascending), perennial and herbaceous, and reach a height of approximately 150 mm. They are therefore aptly referred to as tufted groundcovers, and many individuals together may give a rather mat-like appearance, a sight that is very beautiful when in bloom. Individually they form rounded tufts on the ground of about 200 mm across with very distinctive foliage. The root system of G. krebsiana is fairly weak and consists of a series of adventitious roots. There is no de nite main or taproot meaning the adventitious roots are quite shallow, only about 250 mm deep. This is one of the reasons why these plants react so well to rain and are therefore regarded as excellent pioneer plants.

Gazania krebsiana is an extremely showy plant when in fower, largely due to its warm and bright fower colour, its fower size, and its extended fowering period. The plants are semi-decumbent (prostrate to ascending), perennial and herbaceous, and reach a height of approximately 150 mm. They are therefore aptly referred to as tufted groundcovers, and many individuals together may give a rather mat-like appearance, a sight that is very beautiful when in bloom. Individually they form rounded tufts on the ground of about 200 mm across with very distinctive foliage. The root system of G. krebsiana is fairly weak and consists of a series of adventitious roots. There is no de nite main or taproot meaning the adventitious roots are quite shallow, only about 250 mm deep. This is one of the reasons why these plants react so well to rain and are therefore regarded as excellent pioneer plants.

Just when we need a breath of fresh air in the late summer heat, they happily burst into bloom. At a time when many other plants are already spent, buddleias are just beginning their show. Their passive coloring and texture makes a wonderful backdrop for perennials, and you'll love the butterflies, bees, and hummingbirds that flock to their honey-scented blossoms. Buddleias should be planted in a full sun location with fertile, moist, well-drained soil. Studies have shown that adding lime to the soil will result in increased growth and better floral quality. They are also moderately drought tolerant once established. Since they frequently die all the way back to the ground in northern winters, it is best to cut back all of the old wood to about 12" in the spring. Doing so will result in more compact plants. They will quickly grow back to their normal height by fall and will flower just as prolifically in late summer since they bloom on new wood. You may notice that the flowers tend to be longer and deeper colored in cooler weather. Buddleias tend to break dormancy late in the spring, so don't worry if you don't see anything happening with them when your other shrubs start to leaf-out. These are very durable and reliable plants. 
### **DESCRIPTION\***

Moderately fast-growing evergreen succulent to 12-18" tall x 3-4' wide. This attractive species forms a uniform-looking mound of long, narrow, upright-growing bluish-green foliage that makes a wonderful contrast to deeper-colored, broad-leafed shrubs or succulents. Adding further appeal to this popular species are the cream-colored flowers that appear from late-spring to early-summer. Great for beds, borders, or for use in mixed succulent plantings (ground or container). Requires well-drained soil and little water once fully established, and thrives in a sun to light shade exposure. - Village Nurseries

### **Key Observations from the Plant Palette:**

- Many plants appear in multiple categories (some are listed in both "Immediate Zone Palette" and their specific plant type category).
- The palette emphasizes drought-tolerant, Mediterranean-style plants suitable for coastal Southern California.
- Several plants are noted as particularly good for specific uses like "dwarf varieties," "trailing varieties," or plants that stay under 2 feet.
