Bookmarks

For Chrome on iPhone

When you open a page on Chrome, for example:



On the bottom, there are several icons on the bottom. We'll use those icon names in this article:

- 1. "Previous" icon "<-" takes you to the previous tab
- 2. "Next" icon "->" takes you to the next tab
- 3. "New Tab" icon a "+" icon, for creating a new tab
- 4. "Tabs" icon a square with a number in it, telling you how many open tabs exit. Click on it will show the list of all open tabs
- 5. "More" icon the three dots on the bottom right, giving you many more actions, such as Bookmarks, History, Reading List

Bookmarks can be well organized, and don't really burn your iPhone resources. Just like a file system, you can have folders, subfolders to manage bookmarks.

Manage Bookmarks

- How to see your bookmarks Tap "More" (three dots) at the bottom of the screen, select "Bookmarks" (star icon) you should see all your bookmarks on the iPhone.
- How to add a bookmark Tap "More" (three dots) at the bottom of the screen, select "Add to bookmarks"
- How to edit a bookmark Tap "More" (three dots) at the bottom of the screen, select "Edit bookmark"
- How to move a bookmark Refer to "edit a bookmark" above
- How to delete a bookmark Tap "More" (three dots) at the bottom of the screen, select "Bookmarks" (star icon), select "Edit Bookmark", select "Bookmarks bar", select the folder (if exists), swipe the bookmark you want to delect, select delete.
