CAUTIONIONARY NOTICE

To the residents of: Talega Gallery Community Association in San Clemente

Please be aware that on **Friday, September 04, 2026**, weather permitting, Sims Tree Health Specialists, Inc. will be treating the Palm Trees at this location targeting fungal pathogens (*neodeighttonia spp.*). **Treated trees will be marked by orange yard flags at the base of the tree.**

Most of the materials that are used are mild and have been assigned the signal word CAUTION.

Signal words are standardized terms found on material labels that indicate the relative severity of a hazard. The signal word can be either: DANGER, WARNING or CAUTION. Products with the DANGER signal word are the most toxic, i.e. most household cleaning products like bleach. Products with the signal word CAUTION are lower in toxicity.

The Tree Health Specialist **may arrive as early as 7:00 AM** and will be in a marked Sims vehicle. They may also have a field assistant helping with directing pedestrian and vehicle traffic away from the treated areas or driving the vehicle while the Specialist performs treatments.

This application date is supplied as a courtesy to enable residents to arrange their schedules to be away from the area. This is NOT mandatory. Please follow the suggestions listed below:

1. Turn off air conditioners in the area of the treatment. This is not mandatory for central air conditioners.
2. Close windows and doors in the area of the treatment.
3. Please park all vehicles away from the trees. Those trees that have a vehicle under them will not be treated by the Tree Health Specialist.
 - *Vehicles around treated trees may get water spots on them that can simply be washed off.*
4. Do not enter the treated area until the materials have dried and have had time to set.
Depending on the weather, this is anywhere from 45 minutes to 2 hours.

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5. Pets should not be in the area of treatment until the materials have dried and have had time to set. *As a precautionary measure, please take all water and food dishes inside.*

California law requires that you are given the following information:

Caution: Pesticides are Toxic Chemicals. The California Department of Pesticide Regulation and the United States Environmental Protection Agency allow the unlicensed use of certain pesticides based on existing scientific evidence that there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.

If within 24 hours following application of a pesticide, a person experiences symptoms similar to common seasonal illness comparable to influenza, the person should contact a physician, appropriate licensed health care provider, or the California Poison Control System (1-800-222-1222).
